## CHURCH

The Hanover Department of Social Services contacted Kathy Ritz with a request for temporary assistance for 7 hours per day during the period June 8-11 for someone to provide care for a 21 year old disabled person. This is very short notice, but if anyone feels they could help with this call Kathy Ritz at 746-4911 for further information.

The HELP Program administered by Commonwealth Catholic Charities is looking for volunteers to work an average of 3 hours a week interviewing clients, answering telephones or providing credit counseling. For further information call Ed Soniat at 746-9671.

MCEF The Mechanicsville Emergency Food program has an increase in need and a drop off in donations. We should try to increase our food contributions on food Sunday.

The Virginia Volunteer Emergency Families for Children program. This program places children in crisis in temporary foster homes for a period of up to 21 days until permanent placement can be found. The program maintains a list of families who are interested in taking children in crisis in for 1 to 21 days. When a child in crisis is picked up by social services one of the interested families is contacted and asked whether the specific child can be placed with them. This program seems a good opportunity for families with young children and a stay at home parent, or older couples who would like to provide temporary care for children in crisis.
