How To Pray the Rosary

1. Make the [Sign of the Cross](#) and say the “[Apostles Creed](#).”
 2. Say the “[Our Father](#).”
 3. Say three “[Hail Marys](#).”
 4. Say the “[Glory Be](#).”
 5. Announce the First [Mystery](#); then say the “Our Father.”
 6. Say ten “[Hail Marys](#),” while meditating on the Mystery.
 7. Say the “Glory Be,” then say the “[Fatima Prayer](#).”
 8. Announce the Second Mystery; then say the “Our Father.”
- Repeat 6 and 7 and continue with Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.
9. Say the “[Hail Holy Queen](#).”

Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Apostles Creed
