Johnny: "Sure I do!"

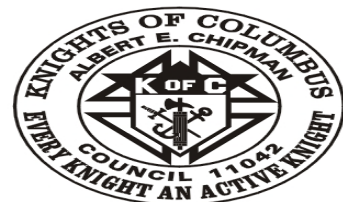
Vito (glancing over his shoulder at Sonny): "Because a man who does not spend time with his family can never be a real man."

Brothers,

Suzy, Nicholas, and I thank all of you for recognizing us with the award of Family of the Year at the Past Grand Knights Dinner. We were most pleasantly surprised and are extremely grateful.

As I interview candidates for membership in the Order, I recall my own admissions interview and my response to the question, "What has drawn you to the Knights of Columbus?" At the time, I knew comparably little of what our council does for the community and less of what the Order does for the Church. But I did know that this is a group of like-minded men who take action to do great things for our Church and our community. My answer was that I identify with and appreciate a group of men who understand that there are things far greater and more important in the world than just themselves and, when called to task, own the problem and do something about it.
